



Washing Insects

Washing Sugar Water Off Your Insect

1. Take your insects out of the sugar water and put them in a clean mason jar or cup.
2. Put a little bit of shampoo on your finger then rub it on the side of the container. Don't put too much!
3. Put the mesh over the top of the container and secure it with a rubber band.
4. Fill the container with water and then empty it. Do this until there are no more bubbles.
5. Dump all of the water out of your container then transfer your clean insects into a dry container.

Drying Your Insect

You can either let them dry naturally or you can blow dry your insects to "fluff" them up!

Naturally Dry:

Set them in a safe place to air dry.

Blow Dry:

1. Put your insects into a dry mason jar or cup
2. Put the mesh over the top of the container and secure it with a rubber band.
3. Turn your blow dryer on low and hold it about one inch from the mesh. Don't put it too close or you will melt the mesh!
4. Blow air into the container until your insect is dry.
